The undersigned Declarant and Petitioners:

being two or more of the officers or agents appointed to supervise or manage the affairs of COOSAW CREEK OWNERS' ASSOCIATION, INC., a South Carolina non-profit corporation which has been duly and regularly organized for the purposes hereinafter to be set forth, do affirm and declare:

That at a meeting of the aforesaid organization, held pursuant to the ByLaws or regulations of the said organization, they were authorized and directed to apply for incorporation.

That the said organization holds, or desires to hold, property in common for a Religious, Educational, Social, Fraternal, Charitable or other eleemosynary purpose, or any two or more of said purposes, and is not organized for the purpose of profit or gain to the members, otherwise than is above stated, or for the insurance of life, health, accident or property; and that the three days' notice in the News & Courier, a newspaper published in the County of Charleston, South Carolina, has been given that the aforesaid Declaration would be filed.

The said Declarant and Petitioners further declare and affirm:

FIRST. Their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND. The name of the proposed Corporation is COOSAW CREEK OWNERS' ASSOCIATION, INC.

THIRD. The place at which it proposes to have its headquarters or to be located is 104 Maxwell Avenue, in the City of Greenwood, South Carolina.

FOURTH. The purpose of the said Corporation is to administer and manage the affairs of the Coosaw Creek Owners' Association, Inc.

FIFTH. The names and residences of all managers, trustees, directors or other Officers are as follows:
